SUBJECT: Nominations of Teachers for the End-of-Course Tests (EOCT) Mathematics Standards Setting

The Georgia Department of Education (GaDOE) is seeking recommendations for judges in the upcoming Georgia EOCT Standards Setting event. This meeting is scheduled for January 12-13, 2010, 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., at a hotel in the Atlanta area. This is a vitally important process to ensure the validity and reliability of Georgia's End-Of-Course Tests.

The sessions will be conducted to determine performance standards in Mathematics I: Algebra/Geometry/Statistics and Mathematics II: Geometry/Algebra II/Statistics. We are soliciting nominations from school districts for teachers (including special education and ESOL teachers) to participate as judges in these sessions. A minimum of 15 to 20 judges will be required for each mathematics course. It is imperative that participants selected for these sessions be committed to attending for the duration of the process.

To ensure that an adequate representation of educators from around Georgia is selected, System Test Coordinators and/or System Curriculum Directors should submit the names of qualified teachers in advanced level Mathematics courses. You may submit up to 1 nomination per district for each course.

In an effort to recruit a balanced, representative committee, not all nominees will be selected. Those nominees not selected for the standards setting event could be included in a pool from which the Assessment Administration Division staff may select individuals for participation in future events related to the EOCT. Participants will be expected to participate in both days of the event. All nominees should be approved by a school administrator and the System Testing Coordinator before registering for the workshop.

Please submit nominations no later than November 6th. To nominate teachers, go to the on-line registration site [Georgia EOCT Mathematics I & II Standard Setting Nominations, Jan. 2010](#) .

Participants will be notified by November 11, 2009, if they are selected to participate in this event. Once selected, participants will be contacted with hotel registration information. Nominees not selected to participate will also be notified at this time.

Substitute reimbursements as well as reimbursements for mileage at the rate of \$.55 per mile and accommodations will be provided for qualifying participants. Breakfast and lunch will be provided to participants. The dinner reimbursement cost is capped at \$20.00.
