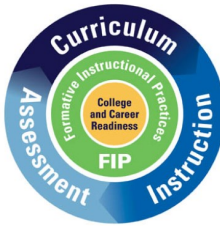

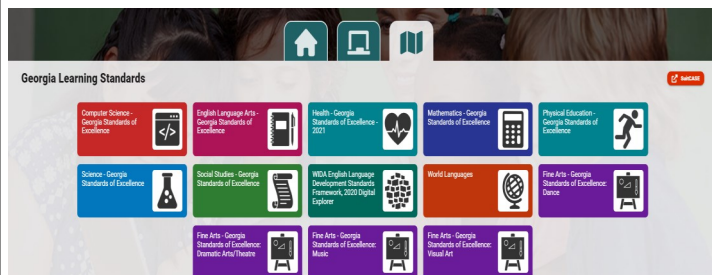

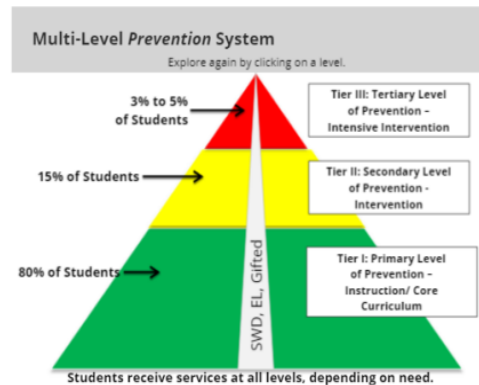

Georgia's Systems of Continuous Improvement

Georgia's Systems of Continuous Improvement (GSCI) framework focuses on the systems and structures (the "what") that must be in place for sustained improvement in student outcomes. It also utilizes a problem-solving model (the "how") to provide a straightforward process for identifying needs, planning, implementing, monitoring, and evaluating improvement efforts. We use the GSCI to guide our work as we support effective leadership using [process guides](#) that support the work of school and district improvement (data-driven decision-making, leadership teams, collaborative planning, and high school graduation toolkit).
